Nursing home ransacked over death of patient

Falta, 4 January

A nursing home was ransacked over the death of a delivery patient after giving birth to a male child at Falta in South 24-Parganas today. Police was attacked and four policemen were injured in the incident.

Sundari Bibi (27), a resident of Sonacopa village of Falta, was admitted to a nursing home of Sahararhat within Falta police limits area on 1 January.

She gave birth to a male child last night at the nursing home. But since then the mother was suffering from profuse bleeding and the doctors of the nursing home shifted her to Diamond Harbour district hospital.

The patient was admitted

to Diamond Harbour hospital but this morning she died.

After that, the relatives and neighbours of the deceased agitated in front of the nursing home with the body of the woman.

The agitators attacked the nursing home some time later, alleging that the patient died due to the negligence of the doctors and the nursing home authorities.

The mob started to ransack the nursing home. They pelted police with stones when the forces tried to resist them. Four policemen and five of the nursing home staff were seriously injured.

RAF was deployed at the spot and the force had to resort to a lathi-charge to disperse the mob.
