Another woman who was sitting beside the victim was also injured when acid touched her body as well. The incident occurred between Baruipur and Kalyanpur Stations in Sealdah south section. Just when the down Diamond Harbour Local, which left Sealdah at 9:40 p.m. started to move towards Kalyanpur from Baruipur station, acid was thrown at

Another woman who was sitting beside her in the compartment was also injured in the acid attack. The youth managed to flee from the train compartment by jumping out. The two
